Frequently Asked Questions

Q1: What is the purpose of this project?

A1:

This project will improve the corridor with a neighbourhood greenway. Neighbourhood greenways are enhanced pedestrian and bicycle connections linking key activity nodes and residential neighbourhoods. Improvements in the neighbourhood greenway include tree lined boulevards, LED lighting, pedestrian connections and cycle facilities.

Q2: Will there be enough parking available when multiple events are taking place at The Landing facilities, such as the Curling Club, Cultural Centre, Evergreen Hall, and will it be available on the roadway?

A2: The design will strike a balance between creating additional landscape/tree line boulevards while maximizing on-street parking. The reduction in available road parking will be 50 stalls, but the planned parking lot expansion adjacent to the Chilliwack Curling Club will add more total parking stalls than will be lost in this project.

Q3: What improvements will there be for pedestrians?

A3: New sidewalks on both sides of the road, along the centre median, as well as three new crosswalks are planned. The addition of LED streetlights and a tree lined buffer between the sidewalk and the travel lane will enhance safety and comfort for pedestrians.

Q4: If I can't turn left into my driveway because of the centre median how will I access my property?

A4: Two mid-block crossings through the median will be provided and allow for U-turns.
