Activity	Conservation Plan
Lawn Sprinkling	<p>Restricted: Even addresses – Wednesday Odd addresses – Thursday 5 - 8am only</p>
New Unestablished Lawns	<p>Restricted: Two-week permit required for daily watering between 5 - 8am only</p>
Gardens, Flowers, Shrubs & Trees	<p>Restricted: Watering using a hand-held container, or hose with a shut off device or soaker hose.</p>
Pools, Spas, and Garden Ponds	<p>No Restrictions: Use of treated drinking water is acceptable</p>
Outdoor Impermeable Surface Washing (Sidewalks, Driveways, Buildings)	<p>Restricted: Washing for aesthetic purposes is prohibited, use of handheld container or hose with shutoff device can be used for painting, or health and safety.</p>
Non-Recirculating and Recirculating Fountains and Water Features	<p>Prohibited: All use of non-recirculating water features using treated drinking water is prohibited. Recirculating features can be used normally.</p>
Outdoor Vehicle and Boat Washing	<p>Restricted: Must use handheld container or hose equipped with spring-loaded shutoff device and should be washed over grass or gravel.</p>
Golf Courses	<p>Restricted: Water tee and green areas normally, fairway watering should be minimized to a maximum of two days per week.</p>
Commercial Flower and Vegetable Farms with the Urban Development Area	<p>Restricted: Limit use to minimum necessary levels.</p>
